PROFESSIONAL SERVICE OFFERINGS

Basic Services of Staff \$695

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations and immediate burials.)

This fee includes: funeral director availability 24/7/365 to respond to initial requests for service, the funeral arrangement conference, preparing and filing necessary paperwork, obtaining necessary authorizations, and coordinating with parties involved in the care and fulfillment of services selected. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs, including insurance and administrative expenses, and governmental compliance.

Education and Guidance for Client Care of the Deceased \$395

Some clients feel generally well prepared to care for their own dead, but would appreciate more information and education tailored to their specific situation. This fee covers licensed mortician oversight and education to lead you through the process of caring for the deceased. Processes included in education: topical disinfection, washing, anointment, refrigerant (Techni-Ice) application, cosmetology, hairstyling, dressing, and casketing/shrouding.

Transportation of the Deceased \$375

We can advise you about vehicle requirements for legally transporting the dead in MN. If you do not have access to a sufficient vehicle, or if you would rather leave the driving to us, we can take care of this for you. This fee for transportation of the deceased using professional vehicles may be selected for events such as: transporting the dead from the place of death to the home or our facility; transporting them to a visitation, funeral, or other event; or transporting them to the cemetery or crematory. (Each of these examples would incur a separate fee.) Traveling beyond 30 miles incurs an additional charge (one-way) of \$1.75 per mile.

Mortician-Provided Care of the Deceased

Perhaps you would like to be involved with the care of your own, but there are some tasks you would rather that our staff completed either on their own or with you. We can tailor almost all of our services to meet your comfort level. These fees cover care of the deceased provided directly by our licensed morticians. You may select only the services you wish, except required services as noted.

We are dedicated to helping you avoid the unnecessary use of toxic chemicals and invasive processes. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial, or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available. In lieu of embalming, we generally recommend the use of Techni-Ice for viewings, vigils, or public visitation.

Event Celebrant Services

Life Celebration Service \$395

This fee covers the work of a certified celebrant to plan, arrange, compose, and officiate a service at the time and place of your choice.

Life Celebration Encore Service \$195

Some clients may plan more than one service to accommodate folks living in different areas. This service is for those who have already planned a Life Celebration with us. The Life Celebration Encore includes officiating a service we previously planned and officiated at another time and place of your choice.

Livestream and Recording of Life Celebration Service (per four hour increment) \$195

This fee covers the use of equipment and the work of a technician to livestream your event via Zoom. Connection instructions will be provided to you to share with attendees. Recordings will be saved on our servers for no more than three months.

Event Supervision and Facility Fees

Community-directed deathcare isn't limited to those with expansive homes! We can help you choose the right place for your services through individual consultation. The following fees cover licensed mortician supervision of funeral events. Of the events listed below, Minnesota state law requires a licensed mortician be present at funeral or graveside events with a deceased person present. We do not charge for supervision of a graveside ceremony that immediately follows another ceremony we supervised.

Cremation Processes

These are the a la carte fees for the cremation process itself, and do not include any labor, transportation, or other costs associated with cremation.

Merchandise

The alternative containers listed below are the only alternative containers we provide. Inspired Journeys does not stock or sell caskets, outer burial containers, or cremated remains containers (urns). We will happily connect you with providers at your request.

Corrugated Cardboard Alternative Container	\$155
This sturdy corrugated container is suitable for burial or flame-based cremation. Its plain white exterior is ready to be decorated by you and yours with markers, paint, stickers, etc.	
Biodegradable Shroud	\$155
This white, zippered shroud is made from a water-soluble PVA plastic that is suitable for burial or green cremation.	
Techni-Ice, per 10 sheets	\$120
These flexible plastic sheets contain polymer beads that absorb water and lock it inside. Once frozen, they are a convenient alternative to dry ice. Several sheets strategically situated around a decedent allow for vigils to take place on private property in compliance with MN state law.	

Courtesy Death Certificate Filing

If you require no assistance with planning or arranging for your services, but would prefer a funeral home to electronically file the death certificate on your behalf, this fee covers the cost of filing the death certificate and producing a disposition permit. This service does not include any planning, coordination, or procurement of other authorizations.

MINIMAL SERVICE PACKAGES

Immediate Burial \$1,695 to \$1,850

Sometimes simplicity is all you need. An immediate burial is best suited to clients with directness in mind. Our charge for immediate burial (without ceremonies) includes basic services of staff, initial transfer of the deceased from the place of death, casketing of the deceased, and transportation to the cemetery. This price does not include embalming, cemetery property, cemetery labor costs, visitation or funeral service, or an outer burial container, if required by the cemetery.

Immediate burial with a container (casket or shroud) you provide..... \$1,695

Immediate burial with our corrugated cardboard alternative container or biodegradable shroud.... \$1,850

Direct Cremation \$2,055 to \$2,210

For clients who wish to expedite a cremation, we are here to assist. Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremonies) includes basic services of staff, initial transfer of the deceased from the place of death, transferring the deceased to an alternative container or shroud, transportation to the crematory, and the cremation process fee (flame-based or green). This price does not include a memorial service or visitation, embalming, or an urn.

Direct Cremation with an alternative container you provide \$2,055

Direct Cremation with our corrugated cardboard alternative container or biodegradable shroud.....\$2,210

Important Notes About Direct Cremation Containers:

Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are made of corrugated cardboard or biodegradable plastic.

Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for alkaline hydrolysis. If you want to arrange for alkaline hydrolysis, you can use an alkaline hydrolysis container. An alkaline hydrolysis container is a hydrolysable or biodegradable closed container or pouch resistant to leakage of bodily fluids that encases the body and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into an alkaline hydrolysis vessel. The containers we provide are biodegradable plastic shrouds.
